Copyright 101

In essence, copyright can be defined as an exclusive right to deal with "original works" or "subject matter other than works" in particular ways. For example, if I own the copyright in a graphic design I have the right to reproduce the work, licence this work out to third parties to use or assign the ownership of the copyright in the work to another person for a sum of money.

People who do not own the copyright or are not licenced to use the copyright do not have these rights to deal with this work in these ways.
