The Conference was well received with many highlights to it.

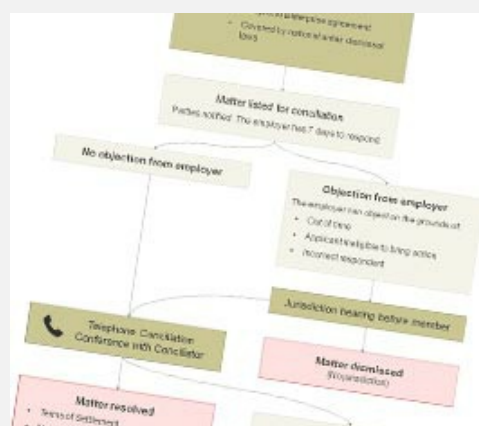
The year has started off on a high-note for Corney & Lind and we look forward to serving you in 2018.
